■ Numbers, Spelling, Subject-Verb Agreement

By the 1820s, the average American were drinking 7 gallons of pure alcohol every year.

■ Plurals, Verb (Irregular), Abbreviations

In 1835, Oberlin College becomed the 1st college to admit woman.

■ Using the Right Word, End Punctuation, Run-On Sentence

Nat Turner, a slave and preacher, lead a slave revolt in 1831 beside 60 white Virginians, 20 black slaves also dyed

■ Capitalization, Verb (Tense), Spelling

The Mexican-american war ended in 1848, and the United States gains 525,000 square miles of terratory from mexico.

■ Comma Splice, Verb (Tense), Using the Right Word, Comma (Interruptions)

Early in the Civil War, African Americans from the North tried too enlist, the Union army however rejects them at first.
